Enviro Week "What Can We Do About Climate Change"



Speakers: **Dr George Takacs** is a physicist at University of Wollongong. Lecturing in nuclear physics, and biomedical physics. He is currently conducting research into fuel cells, and radiation transport with a long term interest in energy and the environment. Dr Takacs is a member of the Wollongong Climate Action Network. His subject will be Australia's greenhouse gas emissions compared to other countries, as well as highlighting measures being taken in other countries.

Rowan Huxtable is an engineering manager. He has extensive experience with industrial engineering, 20 years of involvement in climate change issues and is a foundation member of Wollongong Climate Action Network. Rowan's précis is "We have to act on climate change, Our actions in Australia are important. There are valuable things to do right now...so lets do it"

Ben van der Wijngaart is the Federal Greens candidate for Gilmore. He will speak from personal experience on setting up renewable energy in his own home in Kiama. He also has considerable knowledge regarding wind power.

David Tranter, D.Sc., OAM, is a retired CSIRO Oceanographer and the author of the recently published book 'Nature and Society'. David will speak about Aspects of Climate Science, in particular "Septic Simplification".
