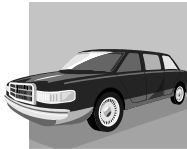

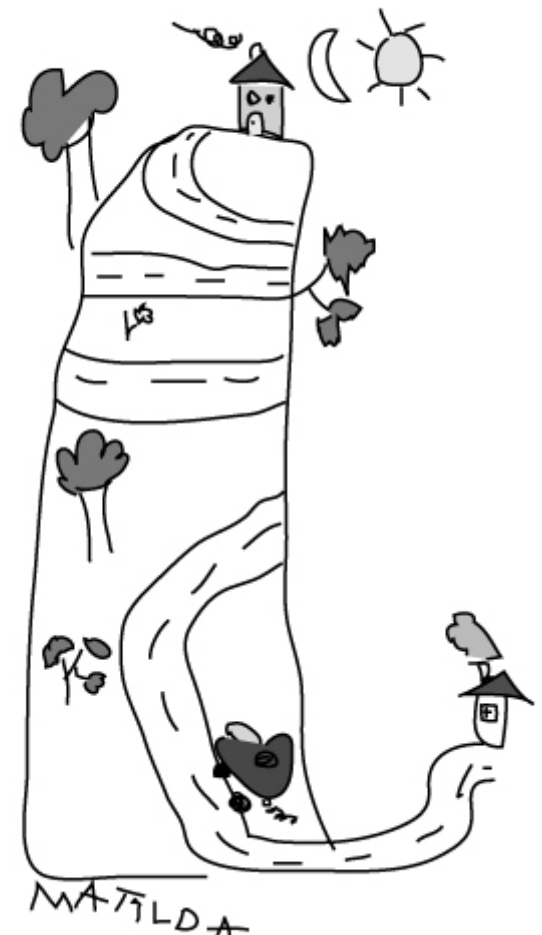

## Bus Services – school and local

Operate regular commercial services and dedicated school bus services across the Southern Highlands, including from Robertson to Moss Vale and Bowral. Buses are also available for charter and the fleet includes buses designed for disabled access.

Timetables can be posted out, picked up from their office in Mittagong or viewed on their website.

Route 808 travels through Robertson. There is also an 808 route that travels through Kangaloon, East Kangaloon, Glenquarry, Chevalier College, Bowral and Mittagong.

### Taxi Transport Subsidy Scheme

The scheme was introduced in 1981 to assist residents of NSW who are unable to use public transport because of a qualifying severe and permanent disability. The scheme subsidises the travel cost of TTSS participants, allowing them to travel by taxi at half fare. The maximum subsidy that can be claimed is \$30.00. The way that eligible people can use the TTSS scheme is by using NSW travel dockets to substitute for part of the taxi fare. Once approval for acceptance to the scheme is granted you will be issued with a book of travel dockets.
