# Bus Services



Did you know that Southern Highlands Community

Transport provides a bus service to Bowral every Wednesday fortnight. Due to the lack of alternative transport this bus service is available to all residents in the Robertson area, including Kangaloon, Mt Murray and Burrawang.

The bus leaves Robertson approx. 9:30am and travels through to Burrawang and then onto Bowral. The bus parks at Oxley Mall and departs at 2pm for the return journey. We will collect you from your home and our volunteer driver and assistant can assist you with parcels and boarding if required. We can also drop you off en route if you would like to make doctors appointments, visit the hospital etc.

Bookings are essential so we can provide the driver with a passenger list. You might like to become a permanent passenger and we will pick you up automatically unless you notify us otherwise.

The Community Bus is also available for hire to Community groups and Associations at a minimal cost. If you would like to book a seat on the bus, or find out more information about bus hire please ring Cathy Baker on 4862 1122 between 1 and 5pm Monday to Friday.




